Recent school report

1. Teachers' professional development:

- a. From 17 to 31 July, Ms Lie Wai Ling, Mr Ma Fung Cho and Mr Zhong Hui acted as the P3 BCA and P6 TSA Assistant Examiner and markers.
- b. From 24 to 29 July, Mr Chow attended a seminar of Mathematics Education in Shanghai.
- c. From 24 to 28 July, Mr Tam Wai Wa participated in the Changsha exchange tour to see the historical monuments and modern buildings.
- d. On 17 August, teachers attended a meeting in the University of Hong Kong aiming at discussing a senior primary level writing teaching support scheme.
- e. On 18 August, teachers attended a seminar about the support scheme of Mathematics for the new school year. The scheme was held by the University of Hong Kong.
- f. On 30 August, teachers attended a seminar about a support scheme on teaching English in order to refine small class teaching skills.
- g. On 31 August, an English expert, Dr Tang led a workshop titled "Workshop on Phonics Teaching". All our English teachers attended to discuss a related school-based support programme about phonics for the new school year and the expert provided precious opinion on the development of our English subject.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 6 July, all P6 students attended the Teacher Appreciation Lunch gathering to express their thanks to all the teachers.
- b. On 6 and 12 July, students participated in a summer activity; they visited Hong Kong Wetland Park. Their knowledge and understanding of the inherent values of wetlands were uplifted.
- c. On 7 July, students visited Trick Eye Museum Hong Kong and The Peak. They admired the beautiful scenery of Hong Kong.
- d. On 11 July, secondary places allocation results were released, with all our P6 students being able to get into their target secondary schools. 90% of our students were allocated to one of their first three choices. This figure is higher than the territory average. About one third of the students entered EMI secondary schools. All our teachers and students felt proud of it.
- e. On 12 July, students joined a summer activity to visit the Tao Heung Centralized Food Processing and Logistics Centre. The participants learnt about massive food production procedures.
- f. On 13 July, our students paid a visit to 4D Magical World, Tuen Mun Public Riding School and Cyberport. Our students could gain different learning experiences.
- g. On 14 July, our students participated in a summer day camp. Some teachers brought them to Sai Kung Outdoor Recreation Centre to engage in some meaningful healthy group activities. Students' self-managing skills was honed. On the same day, our students visited the Science Museum to learn about the world science and technology. The participants' horizons were broadened and their enquiry spirit was uplifted.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On 4 July, it's our school's Graduation Ceremony. The performance of our students was a great addition to the attractions of our ceremony. All guests appreciated our students' performance.
