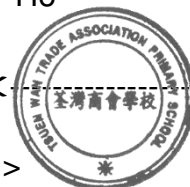

School report for March

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 13 March, teachers of a school from Shenzhen visited us. They observed 2 English lessons which were taught by Ms Sham and Ms Wong, and 2 G.S. lessons which were taught by Mr Chan and Mr Lee. Teachers from both schools shared the teaching experience with each other.
- b. On 20 March, our school was invited to give a talk about Financial Education for the Principals and teachers from Primary schools. In the event, our Principal, Mr K. H. Chow, Mr H.W. Ho shared the experience gained from our school with other teachers.
- c. From 24 to 28 March, our principal, Mr. K. H. Chow was invited to participate in the Tour to visit Guizhou, the Cloud Data Centre and do the preparation work of forming sister school pair with schools in Guizhou.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 2 March, our school organised a Chinese Dressing Day, with activities including booth stalls, and a Chinese dressing Catwalk Competition. The students learnt about the Chinese culture, and enhanced their understanding about the Lunar New Year, as a traditional Chinese festival, and their national identity was strengthened.
- b. From 26 March to 28 March, the Easter activities were held during recess and lunch break. Students enjoyed the activities. The speaking and listening fluency of our students as well as their cultural knowledge of foreign festivals were enhanced.
- c. On 27 March, Chinese learning activities were held for P2 to P3 students. Students learnt words meaning or different sentence structures through booth stalls and games.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On 6 February, our school organised a Community Youth Club charity sale of flowers. Numerous students and parents supported this activity by either purchasing the flowers or donating directly. \$10,400 was raised in this event.
- b. The second Incorporated Management Committee meeting was conducted on 17 March.
- c. On 28 March, PTA committee members visited the kitchen of the lunch box service provider, Danny Catering Service Ltd., to monitor the quality of the production process and to ensure the food safety and hygiene.
- d. Our school has an intention of applying to let all our P3 students take the Territory-wide System Assessment as teachers believe that the independent report can provide useful feedback for us to improve learning and teaching.
